1. Arrive at least 10 minutes prior to training and sign in.
2. Bring your training kit with you (Swimwear, Wetsuit, Goggles, Towel, etc).
3. When told, get changed in to the appropriate kit as quick as you can.
4. Always listen to the coaches and do what they say.
5. Respect all the equipment. Carry and use it the correct way.
6. Always be friendly and supportive towards other club members and welcoming to new members.
7. Do not use bad language or display bad behaviour.
8. Always play fairly and don't cheat (especially during beach flags !)
9. Be gracious in defeat (Shake your opponents hand)
10. Keep yourself safe and look out for others if they are in Danger.
11. Speak to one of the coaches if something is upsetting you.
12. Challenge and report bullying to Safe Guarding Officer. (This will not be tolerated)
13. Don't forget to take all your training kit home with you and leave the clubhouse tidy. Put litter in the bins.
